## Plan Ahead - For Success

- Have an open line of communication with our team about your equipment needs - we are here to help and constantly growing the fleet.
- Include your pump company in jobsite meetings to ensure your needs are met and your pours operate smoothly.
- Review Mix Designs with your sales person.
- Overhead Wires: EXTREMELY DANGEROUS Do not set up or ask an operator to unfold the boom withing 20 feet of any power lines. Call our sales team to determine a safe area to set up prior to the pour date.
- Do not unfold in Wind over 35 MPH makes or Lightning Storms.
- One to One Rule: For every foot of excavation depth, we require one foot setback from the hole for set up.
- Review hand signals with your operator before placing concrete.
